I placed 4th in javelin, discus and shot put. Only two meters off from gold in most events. Once I start training again, I believe I can change these results for next year's game's


Thanks again to the board for allowing me the opportunity to attend and participate.

New Program Open to Eligible Veterans from Rebuilding Together Southern Nevada

Major rehabilitation of 10-15 veterans homes. They will be doing HVAC replacement, insulation, double pane windows, basic weatherization, etc.

To qualify, the homeowner must be a veteran and not exceed 80% Area Median Income. For a single person living alone that's about \$36,000. That number goes up depending on the number of occupants living in the home.

The only caveat is that the homeowner must pay back a portion of the funding **IF** they sell the home in a certain amount of time. Go to RTSNV.org to see this and other programs that may be available to you.




