### **Program Reminders**

Don't forget, we've got two great programs for our members:

#### Adopt-A-Vet:

We will send you a \$50 gift card every month to help with groceries and hygiene products. Call the office to sign up for this program.

#### Step Outside Program:

The Chapter will fund the member and one (1) guest for participation in or attending Basketball, Soccer, Bowling etc., events or will reimburse the member and one (1) guest to attend shows, movies, plays or lunch/dinner, in a sit-down "full service" restaurant.

The amount of the funding will be capped at **\$100.00 per quarter, per member**.

In order to have access to these funds, the member must submit receipts and a short review of the event attended, which will be placed in the newsletter. Receipts and the review **must be** submitted within three (3) weeks of having attended the event in order to be eligible for reimbursement.




